Disembarkation Time Update

Dear Valued Guests and Travel Partners,

The disembarkation time for your upcoming vacation on board Norwegian Dawn on September 5, 2024, has been updated. Travel Partners are asked to share the below information with impacted guests.

In our ongoing commitment to providing exceptional vacation experiences at every step of the cruise journey, listening to our guests is instrumental. Given recent guest feedback, we aim to provide clarity on when the disembarkation process will begin. Although the ship is scheduled to dock in Stockholm, Sweden on September 14, 2024 at 10:00 a.m., disembarkation will begin on September 15, 2024, at 4:00 a.m. local time. Guests with early departure flights will be given priority for disembarkation at 4:00 a.m. All other guests may disembark at their convenience.
