## IMPORTANT INFORMATION Itinerary Change

Dear Valued Guests and Travel Partners,

Thank you for your loyalty and for making us your vacation of choice.

We have important information regarding Norwegian Gem's sailing on May 22, 2023. We ask Travel Partners to share this information with impacted guests.

The Italian government has limited cruise ships of a certain size with the ability to sail into the Venice Lagoon and dock at the piers normally earmarked for large cruise ships with the intention to preserve the lagoon for generations to come. This means, at best, any call to Venice would require cruise ships to anchor outside of the lagoon and utilize tender boats to access the Port of Venice. As a result, we had modified the itineraries for Norwegian Gem to embark from the Port of Trieste and had intended to tender guests to Venice.

While we have made every effort possible to maintain calls to Venice, the tender operation and overall experience this provides our guests has fallen short of the standard we aim to deliver. As a result, our call to Venice will be replaced with an overnight in Trieste, Italy and arrangements have been made to ensure all guests still have the opportunity to explore the magical city of Venice. Please note, while you may take the extended time in Trieste to explore the city, all guests must check-in and embark on May 22, 2023. The all-board time on May 23, 2023 will be announced at the time of embarkation. The revised itinerary is as follows:

Additionally, complimentary transportation will be departing from Trieste on May 23, 2023 at 8:30 a.m. to Venice for guests who wish to spend their day exploring this magical city. Depending on nationality, guests may require a passport and/or a visa to visit certain ports of call. All necessary documentation should be printed and available to present at check-in on embarkation day. Guests who fail to obtain these documents will be denied boarding.
