SHORE EXCURSIONS

Shore excursions booked through NCL for Key West, Florida and Ocho Rios, Jamaica will be automatically canceled, and a full monetary refund of the fare paid will be returned to the form of payment used at the time of reservation; no further action is required. Shore excursions booked through NCL for George Town, Grand Cayman and Great Stirrup Cay, Bahamas will be automatically adjusted to coincide with the new dates/times in port; no further action is required. Shore excursions for Falmouth, Jamaica and Cozumel, Mexico will be available to book in two weeks. If you are interested in booking new excursions for your

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS
