The itinerary for your upcoming vacation on board Norwegian Spirit on December 22, 2024, has changed. Travel Partners are asked to share this information with impacted guests.

We strive to create vacation experiences that delight our guests, but sometimes issues arise, and our itineraries need to be altered. From time to time, ports may become unavailable due to various reasons such as port congestion, maintenance work, or external events. These changes are unfortunately outside of our control and can happen even after we have confirmed dates and times with a port. While port changes may occur, rest assured that we are always working hard to provide you with a smooth and enjoyable journey.

As such, due to damage caused by a recent earthquake, our call to Hualien, Taiwan, has been canceled. However, we are pleased to share that our visit to Kaohsiung, Taiwan, has been extended to an overnight stay. In Kaohsiung, guests can explore the vibrant Liuhe Night Market, take in the stunning views from the Dragon and Tiger Pagodas, or visit the serene Lotus Pond.

Additionally, while we will no longer visit Salomague, Philippines, and Nha Trang, Vietnam, we are pleased to announce that we have added an overnight visit in Singapore and a stop in Currimao, Philippines. In Singapore, guests can explore the iconic Marina Bay Sands, stroll through the lush Gardens by the Bay, enjoy the diverse food scene at hawker centers like Maxwell Food Centre, and experience the vibrant culture of neighborhoods like Chinatown and Little India. In Currimao, visitors can enjoy beautiful coastal scenery, explore historic sites like the Paoay Church, or relax on the pristine beaches of nearby resorts.

Furthermore, we have extended our visit in Phu My (Ho Chi Minh City), Vietnam. Here, guests can explore bustling markets, visit the stunning Vung Tau beach, or take a scenic drive to the historic town of Ba Ria. The revised itinerary is as follows:
