While we try to maintain original itineraries as much as possible, at times modifications are made to accommodate certain circumstances. As such, due to recently imposed port restrictions in Ireland prohibiting tendering operations during the month of October, we have replaced our call to Dublin (Dun Laoghaire), Ireland with a call to Liverpool, United Kingdom.
