SHORE EXCURSIONS

Shore excursions booked through NCL for Santa Marta, Colombia, and Panama City, Panama will be automatically canceled, and a full monetary refund of the fare paid will be returned to the form of payment used at the time of reservation; no further action is required. Shore excursions booked through NCL for Cartagena, Colombia, Manta, Ecuador, Salaverry (Trujillo) and Lima (Callao), Peru



will be automatically adjusted to coincide with new dates/times in port; no further action is required. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Depending on nationality, guests may require a passport and/or a visa to visit certain ports of call.
