As part of our ongoing work to ensure a smooth and thoughtfully planned journey, we're sharing an important update to your itinerary following revised port availability. We kindly ask our travel partners to help ensure impacted guests review the details below.

While we coordinate closely with port authorities to confirm every detail well in advance, operational conditions can change, and at times we're informed that space is no longer available. We understand that itinerary changes can bring disappointment, and we truly appreciate your understanding and flexibility.

As part of this update, Norwegian Prima will no longer call on Riga, Latvia. Instead, we're delighted to welcome Kiel, Germany to your journey, a charming Baltic port where maritime history meets easy coastal living. With its walkable city center, inviting waterfront, and relaxed pace, Kiel offers a wonderful opportunity to explore ashore, linger along the harbor, and take in everyday life by the sea.

Additionally, our time in port for Klaipėda, Lithuania, and Gdynia (Gdańsk), Poland, has been adjusted to support the overall flow of your voyage. Your updated itinerary is outlined below.
