Similar to Invergordon, Aberdeen offers scenic Highland landscapes, easy access to historic castles and whisky distilleries, and a rich maritime heritage, while also inviting you to explore its striking granite architecture and vibrant cultural scene. As part of this change, we've also fine-tuned the timing of our visits to Belfast, Northern Ireland, Liverpool, England, Dublin (Dún Laoghaire), Ireland, and Cork (Cobh), Ireland, to help you make the most of your time ashore and ensure a more seamless journey from port to port.
